



***College Baseball Players From
Holy Family***

Tyler Johnson (HF 2005)



- **Years at Holy Family - 4**
College: St. Olaf
- Tyler Johnson was a Varsity player from 2002-2005 here at Holy Family. He was a member of the 2005 section championship team. Tyler both pitched and played SS. His name appears all over the HF baseball record book. Some high school highlights include hitting the 3-run home run and earning the victory on the mound in game 3 of the 2005 section finals. Tyler also earned a win in our second game of the State Torunament defeating Albany 5-4.
- Tyler played for St. Olaf. Tyler played 1B for his first 3 years. In 2009 he went back to playing SS and 2B. Tyler Johnson was a captain for St. Olaf Baseball in the 2009 season. He tied the St. Olaf single season record for home runs with 13 in his Senior year and helped lead them to a MIAC championship and a 2nd place finish in regionals in 2009.

Alex Sommer (HF 2005)



- **Years at Holy Family - 4**
College: St. Olaf
- Alex was a member of the Varsity team from 2002-2005. Alex was a pitcher and middle infielder during his time here. He holds many pitching records and also is top 10 in many offensive categories as well. Some of his highlights include pitching us to a section title going 3-0 in the section tournament and striking out an HF single season record 87 batters on the year.
- Alex was a pitcher at St. Olaf college. He has started games for them since his freshman year. Alex finished his college career with a complete game shutout of St. Thomas (St. Thomas went on to win the National Championship in 2009) in the MIAC conference championship game. This win gave St. Olaf a birth in the regional Tournament.

Zack Chalgren (HF 2005)



- **Years at Holy Family - 4**
College: St. Olaf
- Zack was a member of the HF baseball team from 2002-2005. Zack played many positions while he was here. Those include 3B, 1B and pitcher. Zack's name can be found throughout the record book in both hitting and pitching categories. He currently holds the career hits record at 83. He has many memorable moments but his biggest one may have been his game-winning RBI single off All-State pitcher Tyler Oakes vs. Jordan in the 2005 Sub-Section championship game.
- Zack was involved in the St. Olaf baseball program for 2 years before transferring to St. Thomas and earning a Law Degree.

Matt Michels (HF 2005)



- **Years at Holy Family - 4**
College: St. Mary's University(Winona)
- Matt played for Holy Family from 2002-2005. He was the team MVP in the schools second year of Varsity competition. He was our lead-off hitter for many years. He played a solid centerfield. Matt is the current career record holder in stolen bases with 42. Matt's top accomplishment was batting .889 with an on-base % of .916 in the section finals series which was 3 games. He proved to be a tough out which led to stolen bases, runs and a section title.
- Matt played Outfield in the St. Mary's Winona baseball program for three years.

Jordan Rasmussen (HF 2007)



- **Years at Holy Family - 4**
College: St. John's University
- Jordan played Varsity ball from 2005-2007. Jordan was a two time All-Conference player and team MVP. Jordan played 1B and pitched. When he graduated he held some team records. In 2007, he broke the single season Batting Ave. record hitting .438. He also reached the .600 mark in slugging % with a .613% which at the time was 2nd all-time for Holy Family. This was a result of his 10 doubles. One of Jordan's greatest highlights was his pitching performance in the 2007 sub-section semi-final game vs. Blake. He was masterful on the mound. He also doubled with one out in the bottom of the 8th and scored the winning run to lead up to our 2nd sub-section final game and earned All-Section honors in 2007.
- Jordan played in the JV program as a freshman at St. John's.

Tony Bauer (HF 2009)



- **Years at Holy Family - 4**
College: St. John's University
- Tony Bauer was a 4 year Varsity player. He played 3B and OF his freshman year. Tony then went to his natural position of Catcher for the following 3 years. Tony was an All-Conference Selection in his Junior year and was a big contributor to our 2008 Section 2AA Chamionship.
- Tony played JV baseball in 2010 for St. John's. After that he moved his skills to the St. John's Club Rugby team where he won 2 National Championships. Tony Bauer has helped the HF Baseball program as an assistant coach for our 16U and Legion teams which began in 2012.

Miles Campbell (HF 2010)



- **Years at Holy Family: 4**
College: Bemidji State
- Miles Campbell was a 3 year ace of our pitching staff from 2008-2010. As a sophomore, Miles led us to our 2nd State Tournament Appearance. Miles was a 2-time All-Conference Selection ('09,'10) and was named the 2010 Minnesota River Conference Player of the Year. Miles was named Class AA All-State and to the West Lion's All-Star Team.
- Miles had a successful career At Bemidji State posting a 7-6 career record in 20 starts. He threw 142 innings over the course of his career in a tough Northern Sun Conference.

Jackson Hallahan (HF 2010)



- **Years at Holy Family: 2**
College: Holy Cross, South Bend
- Jackson was a 2 time all-conference player for the Fire from 2009-2010. Jackson played 3B, SS, 2B, C and P. Jackson helped lead the way to our 2nd conference championship in 2010 and section 2AA runner-up. He began his college baseball career at Holy Cross in South Bend in the 2011 season.
- Jackson played 3 years at Holy Cross and 1 at UW-Stout. Jackson finished his college career with a batting average over .300 and started in 162 games during his college career.

Patrick Gullickson (HF 2011)



- **Years at Holy Family: 4**
College: Holy Cross & UW-Stout
- Patrick was a 2-time Minnesota River All-Conference Selection ('10,'11). Patrick was one fo the most versatile players ever to play for Holy Family. He started games in his career at P, 1B, 3B, RF and C. This helped Partick contribute to our back to back conference championships ('10,'11) in many ways. Patrick began his college career at Holy Cross in South bend but is now finishing at UW-Stout.
- Patrick has relished in his role in college as a Pitcher winning player of the week honors in April of 2014 for the UW-Stout Blue Devils.

Chris Knoll (HF 2011)



- **Years at Holy Family: 4**
College: University of North Dakota
- Chris Knoll was a two-year starter for Holy Family. He played 1B and pitched. Chris set a Holy Family record with a .480 batting average his senior year. He was a Minnesota River All-Conference Selection and named MRC Player of the Year in 2011. He was also named to the 2011 Class AA All-State and West Lion's All-Star Team.
- Chris has appeared in 17 games on the mound for UND since his career began.

Jeff Soule (HF 2011)



- **Years at Holy Family: 4**
College: University of St. Thomas
- Jeff Soule was a 4 year letter winner at Holy Family. Jeff played Centerfield in '09 and '10 and was part of 2 conference championships. He earned All-Conference honors in 2010. Jeff hit .703 in his final Legion season before suffering a season ending injury in the 2010-11 basketball season.
- Jeff played for the University of St. Thomas in 2012

Jordan Hollen (HF 2012)



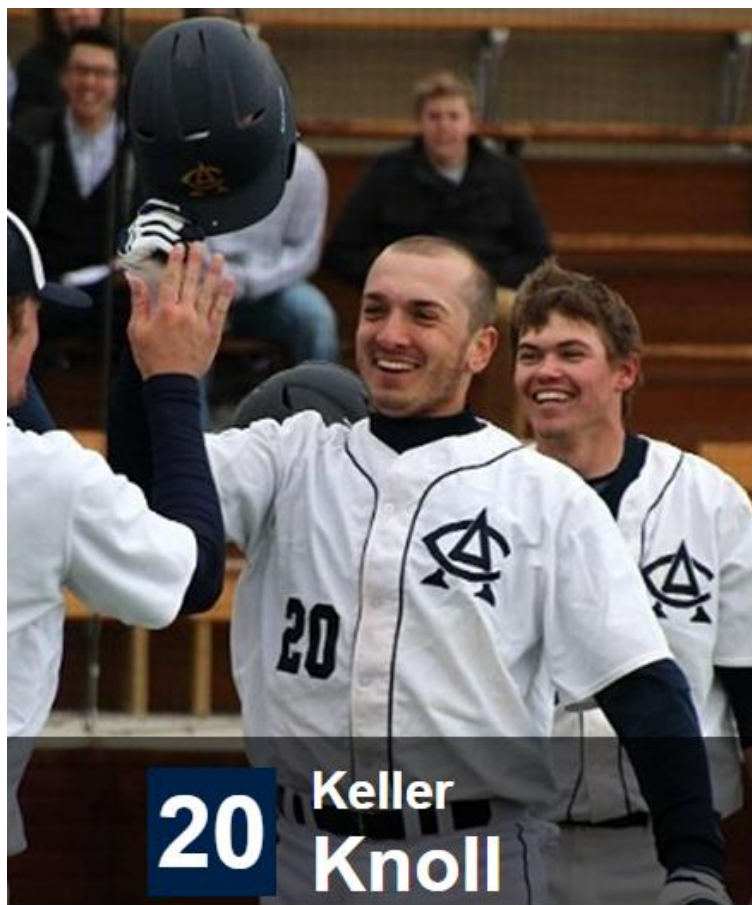
- **Years at Holy Family: 4**
College: Holy Cross, South Bend
- Jordan was a 2 year letter winner at Holy Family in baseball and a 3 letter winner for football. Jordan started in CF in both his Jr. and Sr. year and was a part of 2 conference championship, Section Runner Up and State Championship teams. Jordan was named Minnesota River All-Conference in 2011 and team Captain in 2012.
- Jordan went on to play College Baseball at Holy Cross

Kasey Ralston (HF 2012)



- **Years at Holy Family: 4**
College: Indiana University & St. Thomas University
- Kasey Ralston was a 4 year Varsity starter at Holy Family. Kasey led his team to its first State Championship in 2012. Kasey set school records in pitching in Senior year with 106 strikeouts, 0.53 ERA and a 9-0 record. He also smashed 7 Home Runs in the first year of the new BBCORE bat. Kasey was all-conference in 2011 and 2012, MRC Pitcher of the Year in 2011, 2012 West Lion's All-Star selection, AA All-State 2012, AA All-Acadmic State 2012, Mr. Baseball Finalist 2012, All-State Tournament Team 2012, Class AA Player of the Year 2012.
- Kasey was Red-Shirted as a freshman at Indiana. Ralston miraculously recovered from a near death car accident and has fought back to be able to play baseball again. He has transferred back home to play for St. Thomas University.

Keller Knoll (HF 2013)



- **Years at Holy Family: 4**
College: Augustanna & St. Thomas
Keller was a 3 year Varsity Starter at Holy Family. He was our catcher on our 2012 State Championship team. Keller ranks 5th all-time at HF in Home Runs and 2 all-time in career doubles with 19. Keller was a 2-time All-Conference selection. Keller also was selected to the 2013 Play Ball MN West Metro All-Star Team along with the Class AA All-State Team.
- Keller earned a scholarship to Augustanna. He appeared in 9 games and hit a home run in his first conference at bat.
- Keller has transferred to St. Thomas University to begin the 2015 season.

Rollie Lacy (HF 2013)



- **Years at Holy Family: 4**
College: Creighton University
Rollie was a 2 year starter on the mound for HF in 2012 and 2013. Rollie went 12-0 in his career including wins in the Section Finals and State Semi Finals in 2012. He holds the career ERA record of 0.87 which includes a 0.00 ERA in his Senior Season as the Ace of the staff. Rollie earn All-State Honors in 2013 along with playing in the MN HS Baseball All-Star game.
- Rollie is currently playing in the Creighton Baseball Program

Conner Riddle (HF 2013)



- **Years at Holy Family: 4**
College: Grandview University
Conner was a 3-year letter winner for HF Baseball. The highlight of his career was smashing 2 doubles at Target Field on the 2012 State Championship Game which drove in 3 runs. That postseason, Conner hit safely in all 9 games. He also set the HF school record for doubles in a season with 15. He knocked out 3 HRs his senior year.
- Conner earned a baseball scholarship to Grandview University

Connor Herd (HF 2014)



- **Years at Holy Family: 4**
College: Mercer University
Conner was a 3-year Varsity Starter for HF. Conner earned the win in the section finals to get us to the state tourney in 2012. He also earned a save in the state semis and caught the final out for the State Championship. Conner was a 2-time All-Confernce player in 2013 and 2014. Conner finished 2014 with 6 wins, 69 strikeouts and only 11 walks. Conner also hit .330 in 2014 and earned the trifecta of All-State, Academic All-State and a selection to the MN HS Baseball All-Star Game.
- Conner received a baseball scholarship to Mercer University.
